

TO BE AFFILIATED TO THE FRENCH SOCIAL SECURITY (CPAM)

The researcher, after a month minimum of work in France, has to go to the CPAM in order to affiliate himself and his family to the French Social Security.

<u>European nationals or foreigners who have been affiliated somewhere</u> <u>else in Europe and their families must present:</u>

- The form number 1 104 duly filled in (available at the CPAM)
- The old « Vitale card » (if the researcher had one)
- A Bank Identification Form (RIB)
- A copy of the identity card or passport
- A copy of the birth certificate and/or a fiche individuelle d'état civil (record of civil status, or birth certificates)
- A copy of the wedding certificate if needed.
- A copy of A proof of residence in France (less than 3 month)
- A proof of employment certifying that the researcher :
 - has worked at least 60 hours in the previous month (employer certificate, work contract, pay slip...), or :
 - has paid contributions on the basis of a salary that is at least equal to 60 times the hourly SMIC (the index linked minimum growth wage), over a period of 1 month, or:
 - has worked at least 120 hours, or :
 - has paid contributions on the basis of a salary that is at least equal to 120 times the hourly SMIC, over a period of 3 months, or:
 - has worked at least 1 200 hours, or :
 - has paid contributions on the basis of a salary that is at least equal to 2 030 times the hourly SMIC, over 1 year.
- At least one pay slips

Nationals of non-EU countries and their families must present:

- The same documents and proofs (except for form 1 104)
- The récépissé de demande de carte de séjour (receipt for a residency permit application) or the visa consulaire de séjour temporaire (consular visa for a temporary stay)
